- Royal Decree 831/2014 of 3 October, which establishes the title of Technician in Communicative Mediation and are fixed corresponding educational minimums.
- Order ECD / 1542/2015 of 21 July, which establishes the curriculum of the training cycle for the higher education degree as Technician in Communicative mediation.

Degree obtained: Higher Education Technician in Communicative mediation

Duration:2000hours.(2 academic years)

➤ **Admission requirements:**

- • The academic requirement which allows direct access is bachillerato (LOGSE / LOE).
- • To be in possession of a Technician degree
- • There is a direct access for those who have some of the following academic accreditations:
 - -To have completed the second course of any form of experimental Bachillerato
 - -To have completed the University Orientation Course (COU) or Pre-University (PRICE)
 - • To hold the title of Specialist Technician, Advanced Technician or other equivalent academic title
 - • To hold a university degree or its equivalent.
 - • To have completed the entrance examination.

In the sector of services to the deaf, deafblind, hard of hearing and communication difficulties that are users of the Spanish sign language. These services involve the fields of care, educational, social and occupational and psychosocial support in basic procedures.

They will also work in the sector of services to the community in the areas of community enhancement and the promotion of equal opportunities in these collectives of people.
